Product description

Six kitchen utensils characterised by soft, stylish lines: designed by Valerio Sommella, "Brigata" is a series of utensils that combine practicality with original, sophisticated design. The collection's distinguishing feature is the handle, which is designed to be manageable and well-balanced, and to enhance the appealing shape of the utensils. It is a generous handle that gives importance to items commonly relegated to a purely functional role. The series comprises a Skimmer, a Kitchen fork, a Spatula, a Ladle, a Sauce ladle and a Kitchen spoon. Accessories that are indispensable, but also so attractive that they can be left proudly on display in the kitchen.

Metaproject notes

"The design project of this family is first and foremost the design of a handle. A handle that right from the outset was intended to be a distinguishing feature with excellent functionality. The starting point was the handles used for professional pots: to be precise, the tubular variety that are pressed at the ends and bent, then welded or riveted. Starting from there, we fine-tuned the design to create a handle that is manageable and well-balanced, so that it maintains the original concept but forgoes brutalist construction in favour of a formal elegance that is apparent in the tapered, curved ends, soldered to the various 'heads' that determine the utensil's function."
